



IRISH MISSION JOB DESCRIPTION FOR A BIBLE WORKER

A Bible Worker's overall purpose is to assist the Mission in its stated purpose, which is "to proclaim and teach the everlasting gospel of our Lord and Saviour Jesus".

More specifically the Bible Worker's task is to take the Bible into the hearts and homes of both non-members and members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. This is to be done by means and methods that are commensurate with the standards and objectives of the Seventh-day Adventist Church.

These duties are carried out under the direction of the IM Executive Committee.

The IM Executive Committee normally seeks to do this by assigning the Bible Worker to assist and work alongside and under the supervision of the local minister in:

Evangelism:

- ◆ The evangelism programme of the church
- ◆ The nurture of evangelistic contacts through Bible study, counselling and visitation in their homes to prepare these persons for baptism

Nurture:

- ◆ The nurture of the membership through Bible study, counselling and visitation in their homes
- ◆ The preaching and teaching of the Word in the pulpit, Sabbath School, prayer meetings, outreach programmes and other such meetings as requested by the local minister

Additional:

- ◆ As directed to act as a representative of the IM

In addition to these duties the Bible Worker may from time to time be required to undertake other duties as necessary to meet the purposes of the Irish Mission Executive.
